The Challenge

Removal of the existing properties and brownfield site to make way for the new urban park.

Denbighshire County Council headed the £1.5 million investment in the new West Rhyl Green Space in North Wales which saw the area revitalised with a new urban park and surrounding greenery.

The project was designed by Capita Symonds and Brenig Construction was appointed in September 2014 by Denbighshire County Council to carry out the removal of the existing properties and brownfield site to make way for the new urban park.



The Solution

Tobermore Fusion block paving system.

As a method of achieving a modern landscape for the new green space, Brenig Construction sourced Fusion block paving from Tobermore – a fabulous product with a sparkling granite aggregate surface layer that would produce a unique, contemporary look.

Adam commented on the inclusion of hard landscaping products for the project: *“Block paving was chosen as it provided the park with a high quality finish.”*
